

PRESS RELEASE

Treviso, 25 March 2021 – In light of the rumors reported by some media, Edizione S.r.l. specifies that its subsidiary, Sintonia S.p.A., has already delegated its Designated Representative to express, in the upcoming shareholders' meeting of Atlantia S.p.A. of March 29, a vote against the extension of the deadline for the fulfilment of the suspensive condition referred to art. 7.1 (IX) of the Proportional Partial Demerger Plan of Atlantia S.p.A. in favor of Autostrade Concessioni e Costruzioni S.p.A. ("ACC") approved on January 15, 2021.

Edizione has acknowledged the absence, at present, of proposals from potential investors for the purchase of the stake in ACC that would be held by Atlantia as a result of this demerger - equal, in transparency, to 55% of ASPI - and does not consider it useful to extend the uncertainty deriving from the extension of said term waiting for hypothetical offers for this participation. The above also in light of the binding offer being defined by the consortium of investors headed by Cassa Depositi e Prestiti for the purchase of the entire capital share of ASPI held by Atlantia in ASPI (equal to 88%).

Edizione considers it more appropriate to cultivate the only offer expressed by the market and, in reaffirming its confidence in the work of the Board of Directors of Atlantia, hopes that the offer will then be submitted to the vote of the Shareholders' Meeting for its evaluation by all Shareholders.
